1. Which is most important in a friendship?
 - loyalty
 - generosity
 - honesty
2. You won \$500, what will you do with the money?
 - spend it on yourself
 - save it
 - share it with a friend
3. A friend gave you a gift you don't like, what will you do?
 - keep the gift and say thank you
 - tell your friend that you don't like the gift
 - return the gift to the store without telling your friend
4. How do you have the most fun?
 - alone
 - with a large group of people
 - with a few close friends
5. What do you like to do with your friends?
 - go to a mall
 - go to a movie
 - go for a walk
6. Your friend did something that you consider wrong, what will you do?
 - keep quiet
 - talk to your friend about it
 - talk to your parents or someone who could help your friend
7. Your friend is harassing someone you don't know well. What will you do?
 - stick with your friend and join in
 - walk away without saying anything
 - tell your friend to stop
8. Some of your friends want to sneak out in the middle of the night to do something crazy. You don't want to go. What will you do?
 - tell them you think they're crazy and refuse to go
 - go along to avoid being called a nerd
 - talk to an adult because you're afraid someone might get hurt
9. You have a new interest that your best friend doesn't share. What will you do?
 - try to get your friend interested
 - make friends with other people who do share your interest
 - pursue your new interest and try to find some time to spend with your friend
10. Your friend tells you that he/she is infected with HIV. What will you do?
 - learn more about AIDS and continue the friendship as before
 - stop seeing your friend
 - tell everyone so that noone else gets infected
