### Book Bingo



This activity sheet is especially helpful in building sight word recognition and word meanings before the children see the word in print.

Words that are considered challenging or words that might be unclear or poorly understood are selected from a story and written on the board or chart paper.

The students then choose nine of their favorite words from the list and write them on their "Bingo Boxes" card.

Once all the boxes are filled the children listen for clues from the teachers to see if they match any of the words on their card.

Variations on this game are numerous.

- Students can work in pairs to create the clues for another group.
- You can play the game three times by using a different symbol to mark the correct word.
- Clues may be given orally, or read from the board.
